## 1. Annual cutting back

- in late winter or early spring
- preferably when soil is frozen
- leave debris on site if possible
- avoid heavy equipment whenever possible

## 2. Monitoring and adaptive management

1. Debris, sediment, & trash	<ul> <li>none present (check again next time)</li> <li>remove debris</li> <li>identify source</li> <li>repair source to prevent future sediment issues</li> </ul>	
2. Ponding	<ul> <li>no ponding (check again next time)</li> <li>identify cause</li> <li>check soil profile</li> <li>consult soil professional</li> </ul>

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Monitoring element	Action	Notes
3. Erosion	<ul> <li>no erosion (check again next time)</li> <li>identify source</li> <li>repair source to prevent future erosion issues</li> <li>replace soil</li> <li>stabilize soil</li> <li>re-vegetate as soon as possible</li> </ul>	
4. Vegetation	<ul> <li>no damage/dense cover (check again next time)</li> <li>gaps in cover present</li> <li>ID unsuccessful species</li> <li>ID reason for failure</li> <li>replant/reseed with appropriate species</li> <li>evaluate performance of replacement species</li> <li>consult plant professional</li> </ul>	
5. Weeds and Invasive Plants	<ul> <li>none present (check again next time)</li> <li>identify species</li> <li>remove immediately</li> <li>fill gaps with plants &amp; seed of desired species</li> <li>consult with plant professional</li> <li>develop weed management plan</li> </ul>
