Report Illicit Discharges to Streams and Storm Sewers







Signs of an illicit discharge:

- Oil, antifreeze and household chemicals dumped down a storm sewer
- Make-shift pipes or hoses coming from a home or business to a creek
- Foul-smelling and off-color streams and waterways
- Dead fish and other wildlife in a water body
